CITY OF EXETER (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES)
ORDER 2014 (AMENDMENT NO.6) 2023

Exeter City Council in pursuance of its powers under section 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 and Schedule 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers together with the consent of Devon County Council and in consultation with Devon and Cornwall Constabulary;

HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

1. This Order shall come into force on the 15th May 2023 and may be cited as the City of Exeter (Civil Enforcement Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2014 (Amendment No.6) 2023;
2. To change the zoning of a number of City Centre car parks, as identified in the First Schedule, with charges being applied accordingly;
3. To change the name of the 'Premium' zone to 'Central';
4. To extend the charge period for all Central Car Parks, Zone 1 Car Parks, and all Car Parks located in Topsham as identified in the First Schedule;
5. To increase the charge for business and residential parking permits as identified in the Third Schedule, including charging owners of Electric Vehicles that qualify for a residential parking permit;
6. To charge for electricity use through Electric Vehicle charge points in City Council Car Parks as identified in the Third Schedule;
7. To remove the former Clifton Hill pay and display car park from the Order;
8. To change the tariff at Bromhams Farm pay and display car park as identified in the First Schedule.
9. The City of Exeter (Civil Enforcement Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2014 shall have effect as though:
 - a. The First Schedule referred to is the First Schedule annexed hereto.
 - b. The Second Schedule referred to is the Second Schedule annexed hereto; and
 - c. The Third Schedule referred to is the Third Schedule annexed hereto.
10. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment; and
11. The Interpretation Act 1978 or any replacement Act shall apply for the purposes of the interpretation of this Order as it applies in relation to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
