BYELAWS FOR GOOD RULE AND GOVERNMENT

Byelaws made under section 235 of the Local Government Act 1972 by the Council of Exeter City for the good rule and government of the Borough/District of Exeter and for the prevention and suppression of nuisances.

Application

Byelaw 2 applies to the bridges listed in the Schedule.

Climbing upon and hanging from bridges

2. (1) No person shall without reasonable excuse –
 - (a) climb upon or hang from any bridge to which these byelaws applies; or
 - (b) aid, abet, counsel or procure such an act by another.
- (2) "Bridge" includes any abutment, embankment, retaining wall or other work supporting or protecting the bridge.

Penalty

3. Any person offending against these byelaws shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale.

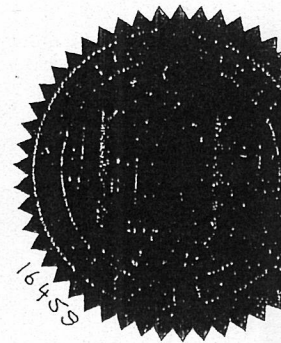
Schedule

2. Trew's Weir Suspension Bridge
3. Millers' Crossing
4. Cricklepit Bridge
5. Kings Arms Bridge
6. Basin Bridge
7. Topsham Bridge
8. Salmon pool Bridge
