How we use your personal information

We use your personal information so that we know who the current owners are for the Burial Rights for a grave. We can then contact you if there are to be any changes to the grave. We are required to do this as part of the contract we have in place with you.

What we will do with it

Your personal information will be held and used by the council. We will not share your information with any other people or organisations unless we are legally obliged to do so.

How long will we keep your information?

We will keep the information for the duration of the contract. Our Corporate Retention and Disposal Policy sets out how long we are required to keep your information for the duration of your contract. When we no longer need to keep it we will destroy it.

What will happen if you don't provide your personal information?

If you do not provide us with your personal information then you will be unable to purchase the Burial Rights or Memorial Rights to a burial plot.
