BYELAW FOR GOOD RULE AND GOVERNMENT

Byelaws made under section 235 of the Local Government Act 1972 by the Exeter City Council for the good rule and government of the City of Exeter and for the prevention and suppression of nuisances.

General Interpretation

1. In this byelaw:

"the Council" means the Exeter City Council.

"highway" has the same meaning as in the Highways Act 1980.

Application

2. This byelaw applies throughout the City of Exeter.

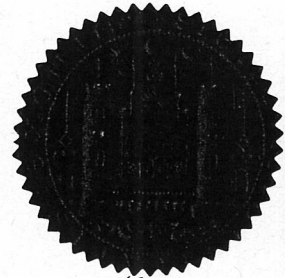
Display of vehicles for sale on the highway

3. No person shall sell or expose or offer for sale any motor vehicle on the highway in the course of a business.

Penalty

4. Any person offending against this byelaw shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale.
