ENVIRONMENT ACT 1995 SECTION 83

THE EXETER AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT AREA ORDER 2007

Whereas it appears to Exeter City Council ("the Council") that the air quality objective for nitrogen dioxide set out in the Air Quality (England) 2000 Regulations and the Air Quality (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2002 was not achieved by 31 December 2005, the Council in exercise of its powers under section 83(1) of the Environment Act 1995 hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall be known as the Exeter Air Quality Management Area Order 2007.
2. The area edged in red on the plan attached to the Order shall be designated as an Air Quality Management Area.
3. This Order shall come into operation on 7th April 2007 and shall remain in force until it is varied or revoked by a subsequent order.
4. The Alphington Corridor and Cowick Street Air Quality Management Area Order 2005, The Heavitree Corridor Air Quality Management Area Order 2005, the Red Cow Village Air Quality Management Area Order 2005, and the Blackboy Rd/ Polsloe Road/ Pinhoe Rd/ Mount Pleasant Rd Junction Air Quality Management Area Order 2005 shall all be varied accordingly.

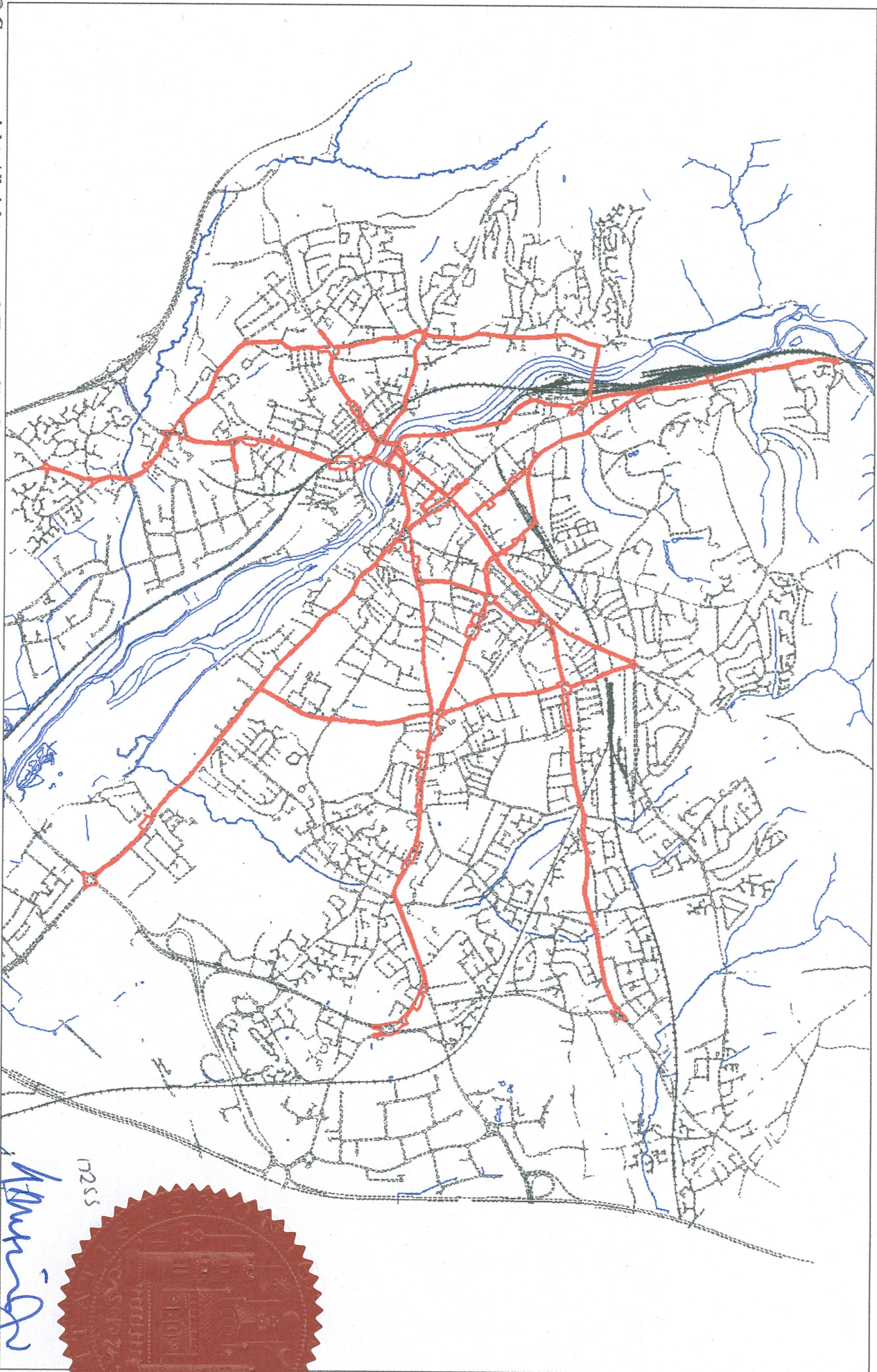
