

Public Open Space Supplementary Planning Document

Adoption Statement

Notice is hereby given that on 20 September 2005 Exeter City Council adopted the Public Open Space Supplementary Planning Document. This document is supported by an Audit of Outdoor Recreation Facilities.

Any person aggrieved by the Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SPD.

Any application for leave may be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
