BYELAWS FOR THE REGULATION OF DOGS

Byelaws made by the Council of the City of Exeter under Section 164 of the Public Health Act 1875, Sections 12 and 15 of the Open Spaces Act 1906 Section 15 of the Open Spaces Act 1906 and Section 235 of the Local Government Act 1972 with regard to public walks, pleasure grounds and open spaces.

1. In these Byelaws:
"The Council" means the Council of the City of Exeter.
2. The Second Schedule of the Byelaws made by the Council on 5 December 1989 for the regulation of dogs shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

SECOND SCHEDULE

CANINE FAECES REMOVAL AREAS

GROUND REGULATED UNDER SECTION 164 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACT 1875

- (i) All those parts of Bull Meadow, Bull Meadow Road, Exeter which are not subject to Byelaw 3 and Schedule 1 hereof.
- (ii) Exwick Playing Field, Exwick, Exeter.
- (iii) All those parts of King George V Playing Field not subject to Byelaw 3 and Schedule 1 hereof.
- (iv) All those parts of Heavitree Pleasure Ground, Heavitree, Exeter not subject to Byelaw 3 and Schedule 1 hereof.
- (v) All those parts of Pinhoe (Station Road) Playing Field, Station Road, Pinhoe, Exeter not set aside and enclosed as a children's play area.

GROUND REGULATED UNDER SECTIONS 12 AND 15 OF THE OPEN SPACES ACT 1906

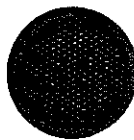
- (i) All those parts of Belmont Pleasure Ground, Belmont Road, Exeter which are not subject to Byelaw 3 and Schedule 1 hereof.
- (ii) All those parts of Cowick Barton Playing Field which are not subject to Byelaw 3 and Schedule 1 hereof.
- (iii) Flowerpot Playing Field, Okehampton Street, Exeter.

GROUND REGULATED UNDER SECTION 235 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1972

- (i) The Cathedral Green and Cloisters, Cathedral Close, Exeter.

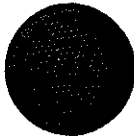
3. The Byelaws dated 5th December 1989 shall be read and construed accordingly.
