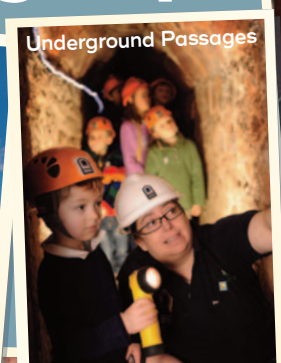
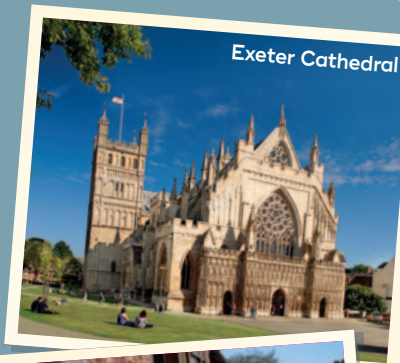

Haven Banks Coach Park

Michael Browning Way - EX2 8DP

Please park in designated parking bays within the car park. Please note: Haven Banks Car Park is locked from 8pm until 7am. Ideal for the Historic Quayside and its attraction, and only a short walk from the City Centre.

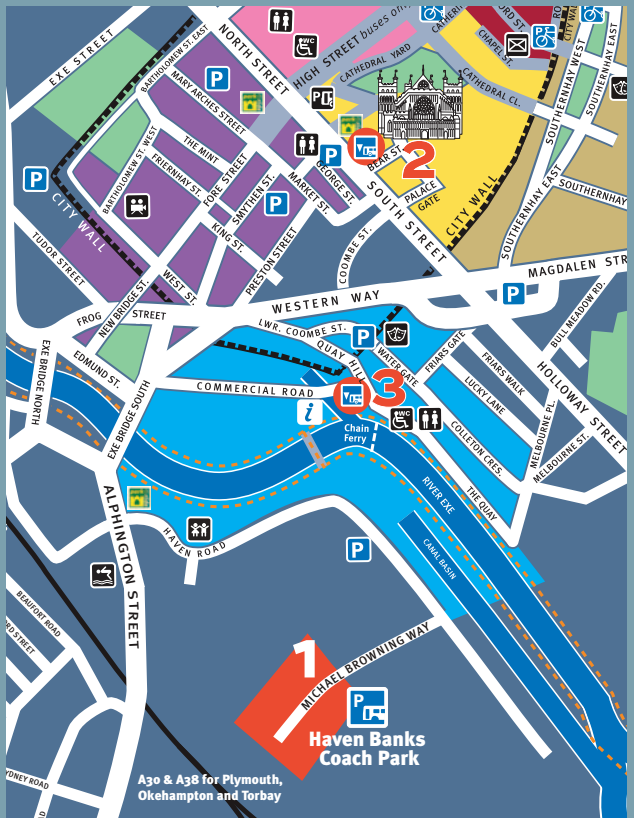
Coach drop off/ pick up in Exeter

South Street - EX1 1DZ

Please drive onto South Street and park in one of the two bays. Please be advised that South Street is part of a one-way system and to check your route into Exeter prior to departing. This is the recommended dropping off point for groups visiting City Centre attractions. Coaches are then requested to park at the Haven Banks Coach Park on Michael Browning Way.

Historic Quayside - EX2 4AN

Groups can be dropped off and collected outside the Custom House Visitor Centre on the Historic Quayside. Coaches are then requested to park on Michael Browning Way.
