

Liveable Water Lane Supplementary Planning Document Adoption Statement

The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) (Regulations) 2012

Notice is hereby given that on 16 July 2024 Exeter City Council adopted the Liveable Water Lane Supplementary Planning Document (SPD), in accordance with the above regulations.

The SPD has been prepared by the City Council to amplify and give guidance on the implementation of policies KP6 of the Exeter Local Plan First Review (adopted 2005) and policy C17 of the Exeter Core Strategy (adopted 2012).

Any persons with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for a judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event no later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
