

Exeter City Council Community Infrastructure Levy Review:

Draft Charging Schedule

Submission Statement

Introduction

As the Local Planning Authority and Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) Charging Authority for Exeter, the City Council has the authority to charge CIL. The City Council has been charging CIL since December 2013. In the intervening ten years there have been significant changes in the city, the development industry and market conditions. This has resulted in a review of CIL rates in the City through an update of the CIL Charging Schedule.

Currently, the City Council charges CIL on the following uses:

- Residential development;
- Student housing; and
- Retail outside of the city centre.

All other development has a zero rate.

Viability evidence

Viability evidence has been compiled to support the CIL review. This work has been put together by Three Dragons consultants. As part of this work, discussions highlighted which uses and development types are likely to have seen significant change since the implementation of the current CIL Charging Schedule. This led to viability evidence focusing on the following uses/development types with new/revised CIL rates proposed:

- Flatted development (introducing a specific zero rate);
- Build to rent (introducing a specific rate);
- Student housing (increasing the rate); and
- Co-living (introducing a specific rate).

The City Council is not proposing to amend the current rates for residential development, out of city centre retail and all other development.

Consultation

Public consultation on the Draft Charging Schedule and supporting evidence was held for six weeks in December 2022 and January 2023. For completeness, the whole Draft Charging Schedule was made available for consultation although only four new or revised rates were proposed for review.

Submission

The City Council is now submitting the Draft Charging Schedule and supporting evidence for independent examination. The submission documents are listed below:
